Very scarce making up the 4d rate on large dated piece each cancelled by A47 numerals with Highgate MR 16 60 Jamaica alongside. LL, ML, NL all show corrosion marks not on Imprimatur sheet but typical of Plate 58. Although all stamps affected by a vertical filing crease and one by horizontal filing crease multiples very scarce used in Jamaica. Cat £1,600 £600
- 355 **JAMAICA A 49 LILLIPUT 6d Z90.** Excellent piece with superb wing margin, cancelled by **exceptional A49** with backstamps **Lilliput 0 JY 8 59 Jamaica** and **Kingston Jamaica JY 9 59.** A49 (3HOS) cancel plus a Lilliput (type P9a) and a Kingston arrival CDS (type K9Ba) dated 9.7.1859 £295
- 356 **JAMAICA A 53 MANDEVILLE 4d Z98.** Very attractive, tied to very large piece by **quite good A53 (3HOS)** to Kingston with Kingston Jamaica A SP 21 59 CDS alongside to Barclays & McDowell £280
- 357 **CARICATURE 1890 Uniform Penny Post Envelope** with insert card, 1d and 2d GV tied by brilliant **STAMP EXHIBITION JUBILEE INTERNATIONAL , ROYAL HORTICULTURAL HALL OC 16 12** Large Double Ring CDS and Imperf 1d Exhibition stamp used as seal on reverse. Scarce usage. £175
